



Code of Conduct for Parents / Guardians / Spectators for Poole Hockey Club

Poole Hockey Club encourages parents/guardians/spectators to take an active interest in their child's development within hockey and asks that they observe the following:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them
- Do not encourage arguing with officials or unfair play
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
- Never force your child to take part in sport
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accept officials' judgements
- Support your child's involvement and help them to understand that the enjoyment of sport and fair play are more important than winning
- Use correct and proper language at all times
